Marlborough's curriculum is bespoke and designed specifically for the children of the town.

Children begin their time at the school in an Early Years setting that follows the Danish 'Hygge' approach. This innovative style of teaching and learning allows children to explore the natural world around them, develop their physical and social skills, and learn to love school!

As children move through the school, they have the opportunity to benefit from specialised sports coaching and

enriching experiences such as trips to Wimbledon, international cricket matches, and visits from Olympic athletes. This passion for sport has resulted in the school being regarded as one of the top-performing sporting schools in the county.

The exciting curriculum is supplemented with truly outstanding provisions, including specialist French teaching, high-quality reading books available to every pupil, and a curriculum designed around equality and diversity to help our children understand the wider world around them.



The school has developed a fantastic Forest School. Here, children can learn to grow vegetables in our poly tunnel to be cooked by our on-site catering team and used in our delicious school dinners! Children learn how to whittle wood, support wildlife, and even roast marshmallows over an open fire in our wooden roundhouse.

Marlborough St Mary's has two Specialist SEND Resource Bases that help us support children with additional needs. 'The Orchard' also has a sensory room, a sensory circuit,

and highly skilled staff to ensure these children receive the support they deserve.

Perhaps our most popular member of the team is 'Woody,' the school dog. Woody is a gentle red fox Labrador who greets children at the gate in the mornings and can usually be found patrolling the corridors in search of treats...
